At our January 4th lunch meeting, we had a presentation from Rob Johnson, the CEO for the Kettle Moraine YMCA. The Kettle Moraine YMCA is a nonprofit organization whose mission is to put Christian principles into practice through programs that build healthy spirit, mind, and body for all. It serves most of Washington and Ozaukee Counties

Rob shared that the YMCA is the number one childcare provider in the state. Among the youth services they provide are several day camps, swim lessons, gymnastics, and organized sports.

He also shared that the Y is beginning some major remodeling to convert three racquetball courts into additional space for a new free-weight center, a flexible multipurpose space accommodating group fitness, cycling, pickleball courts, and licensed child activities.

Juliana is one of those students that we know will be kind to everyone. She is the


