Also at our October 7 Lunch Meeting, in recognition of the 2021 *National Fire Prevention Week* (October 3-9), we were joined by West Bend Fire Department's Chief Gerald Kudek and Deputy Chief Chuck Beistle. Chief Kudek shared that the Wbfd is a full-time fire department, not volunteer, with 3 active fire stations. It responds to over 4000 calls each year.

Deputy Chief Beistle enumerated several initiatives that the Wbfd supports that are youth oriented:

- A Juvenile fire studies program
- A full-semester job shadowing program for high school seniors
- A partnership with the West Bend Area Chamber of Commerce to run a youth leadership program
- Ambulance services for high school athletic events and certain other activities

He also shared that the Wbfd also offers:

- Free home fire safety inspections
- Saturday or Sunday Breakfast at the Fire House for up to eight people

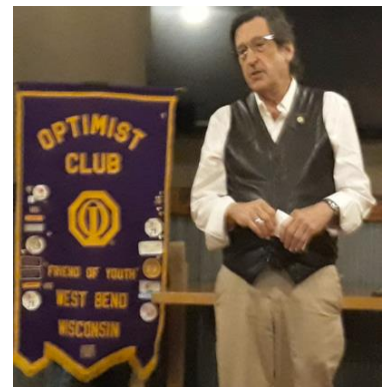
