Competition Rules:

1. Artists must be eleven years old or younger as of October 1, 2021.
2. There are two separate categories of artwork: *Paintings & Drawings*.
3. The artists may submit only one piece of artwork in each category.
4. The artwork is to reflect the artist's concept of: "Optimism"
5. Finished art should be mounted on a frame mat no larger than 16 inches square.

Competition Rules (continued):

7. Artwork is to be submitted by delivering it to the **Circulation/Information Desk** at the *West Bend Community Memorial Library*, 630 Poplar Street, West Bend, WI 53095 (ATTN: Terika Koch)
8. So each entry is judged solely on the quality of the artwork, **no names are to be on the front of the artwork**. The artist's name and any other identifiers may not appear on the front of the artwork, but must be included on the official **Optimist Visual Arts Competition - Entry Form**.
9. The official **Entry Form** must be attached to the back of each entry. It is available for download at: <https://www.optimistclubofwestbend.org/contests.html>.
10. Between April 1 and April 8, the **Optimist Club** will choose the *finalists* in each category (paintings & drawings). The chosen *finalists'* artwork will then be put on public display at the *West Bend Community Memorial Library* between April 9 and April 17, 2022, where it will be judged by the public based on its visual quality and its relationship to the topic: **"Optimism"**
11. First, second, and third place winners in each category as judged by the public will receive an award from the **Optimist Club** and **West Bend Meijer**.
12. The two first place winners (1st place paintings & 1st place drawings) will then be submitted by the **Optimist Club of West Bend** to the **Optimist International Visual Arts Competition** for a chance to win a \$250 scholarship. Their artwork will also be displayed at the **Optimist International** 2022 Convention and featured on the **Optimist International** website.
